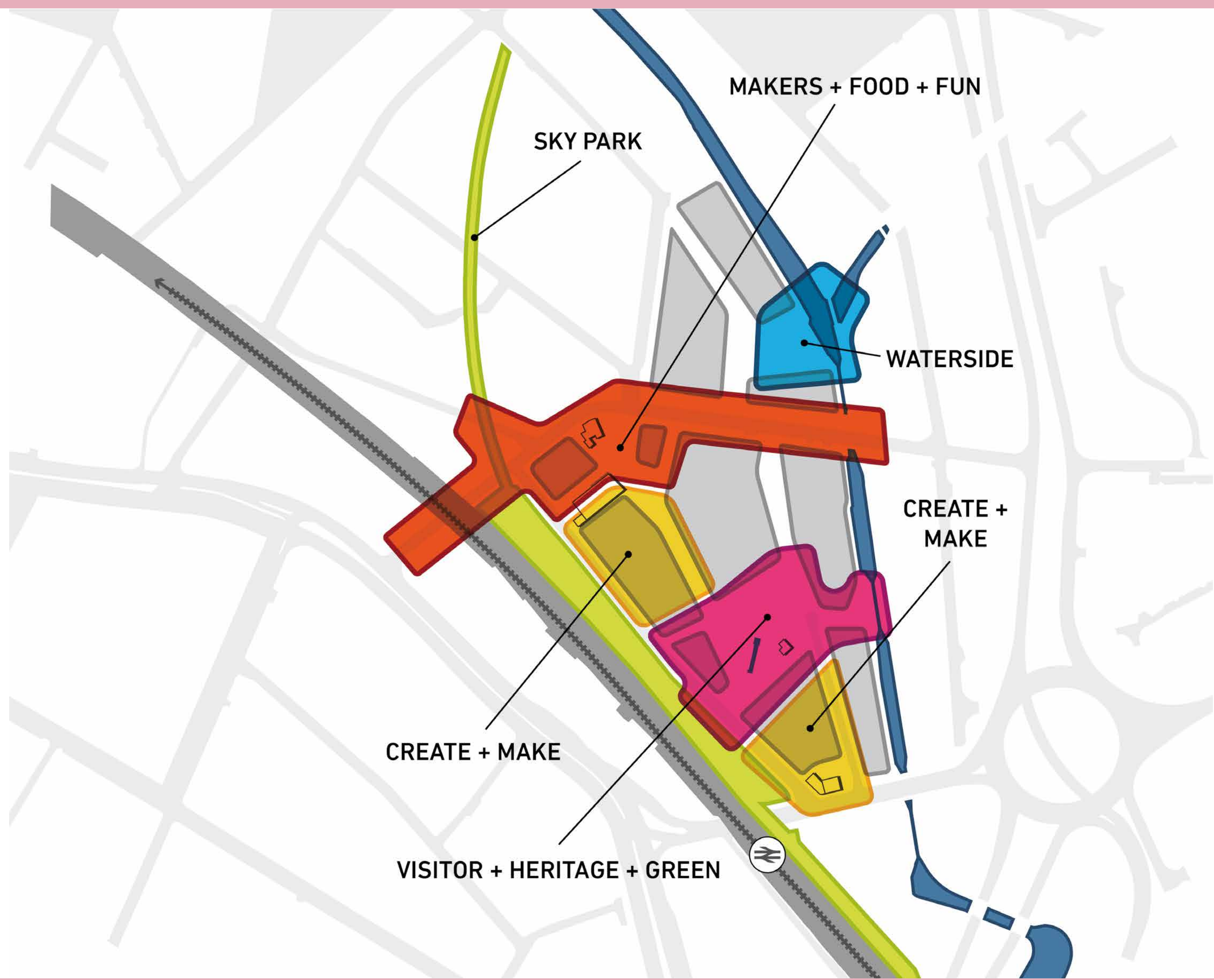


UPPER TRINITY ST. DIGBETH

Outline vision

Our aspiration is to create a new cultural, commercial and residential neighbourhood at Upper Trinity Street, as part of Digbeth's wider regeneration.

We know that Digbeth is a unique place to live or work, with its hidden spaces, eclectic venues, railway viaducts and creative community. It is this 'Digbethness' that we have sought to capture as we have developed our thinking to create a vibrant and attractive neighbourhood to live, work and just be in.

With creative, cultural and commercial spaces at ground level, new urban housing at heights of up to 31 storeys, a new public park with public art and a network of yards and squares Upper Trinity Street will become a destination in itself connecting the existing canal network and proposed Skypark on Duddeston Viaduct to the rest of Digbeth.

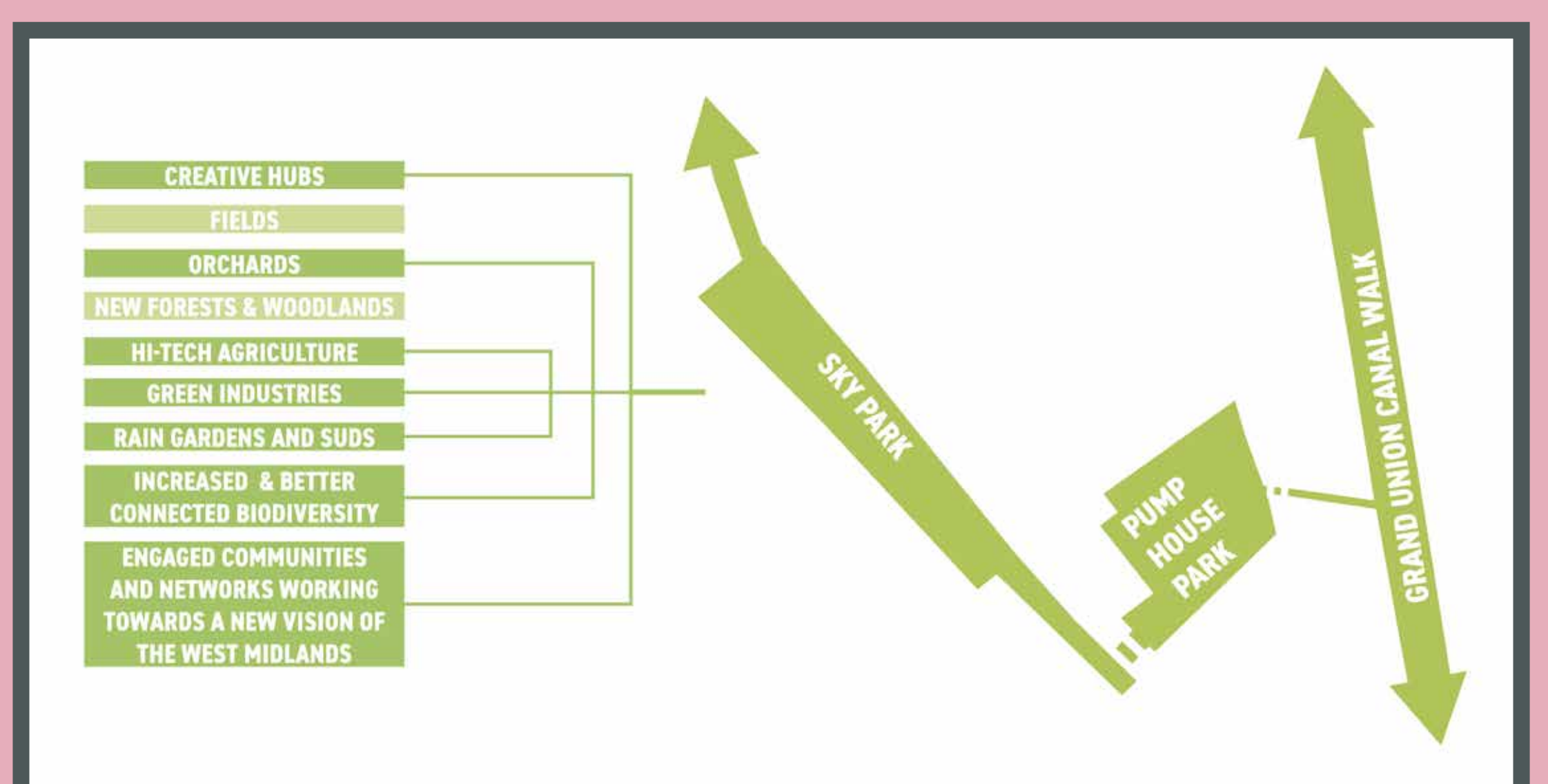
