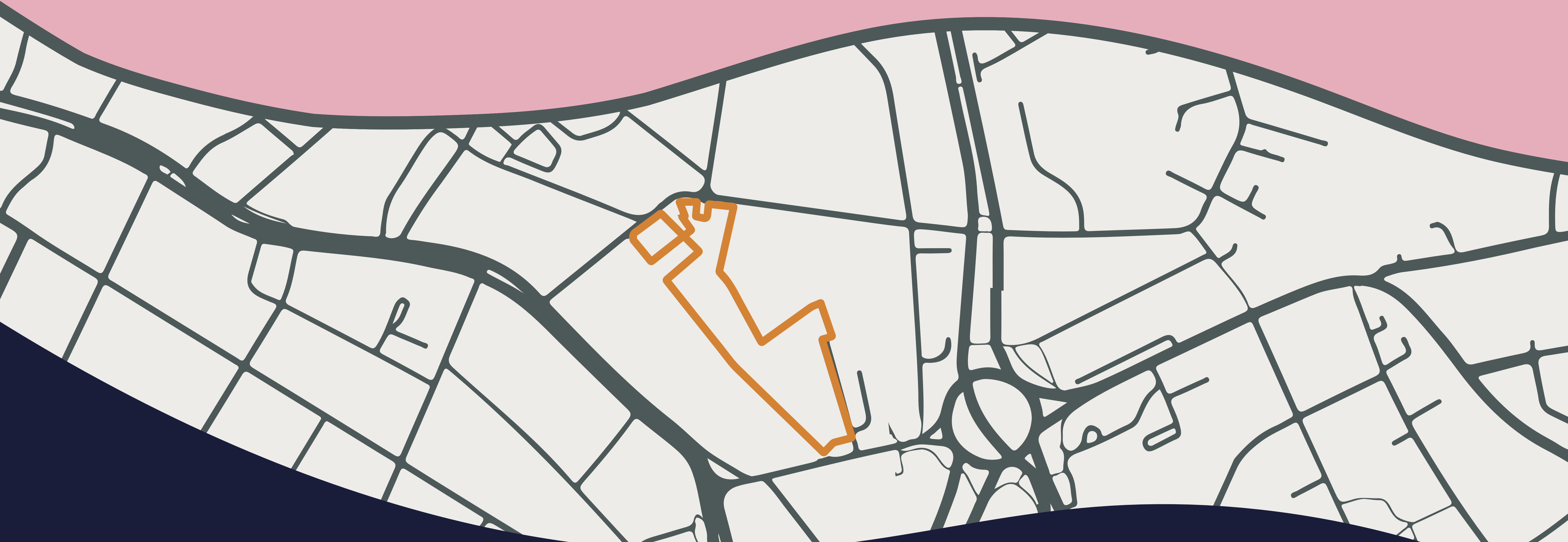
Pump House Park

A major priority for us has been the retention of the Lock Keeper's Cottage and Pump House as well as making a feature of the historic weir. A new and truly distinctive public urban park will become the focal point of the Upper Trinity Street masterplan. Designed around the location's unique heritage and topography, Pump House Park will deliver 4,000 sqm of public realm through a neighbourhood park, the focus of new pedestrian access points between the proposed Skypark and canal network and a visitor destination in its own right.



Skypark

Running at street level along Upper Trinity Street our vision for the site would deliver a southern anchor for the Duddeston Viaduct Skypark, a radical proposal which is being championed and led by the City Council which will transform Digbeth and Birmingham. Our plans will provide a vital connection between the Skypark and the historic canal network creating an integral pedestrian and cycle route into Birmingham City Centre.
